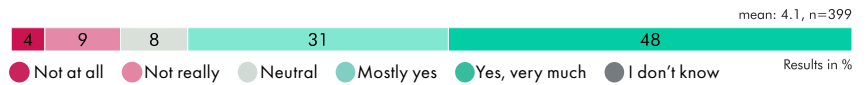


Perception Indicators | Burkina Faso

% of affected people who feel treated with respect by humanitarian actors

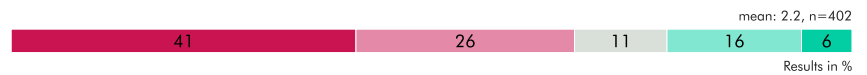


% of affected people who think their views are taken into account by aid providers regarding decisions made about the assistance they receive

% of affected people who think they can earn their livelihood by working in the local economy



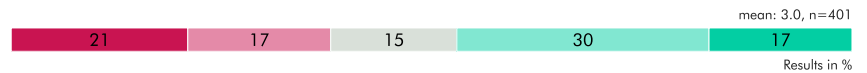
Resilience

% of affected people who feel that the aid they receive will enable them to live without aid in the future

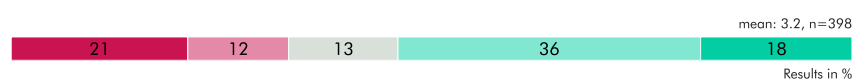


Information and communication
